Mezclada is the conjugated feminine form of the verb 'mezclar' in Spanish, which means 'to mix'. The inspiration derives from the power that diversity of thought, systems, and agricultural practices have on our communities. The mixing of cultures, languages, and belief systems is one of the defining characteristics of this moment in time, especially within rural communities.

We are on a mission to reduce racial disparities, improve ecological integrity, and build strong towns by creating spaces and opportunities for people to discover what it feels like to practice self-sovereignty. We plan to accomplish this through our farm, cafe, and educational offerings.

Imagine spending months immersed in the joyful, busy, and creative work of an online learning community of farmers! Your days as a Co-Facilitator are filled with supporting the onboarding of our farmer students, helping with our pre-launch marketing strategy, coordinating guest speakers for class, exploring the inner workings of a budding startup, facilitation and logistical wrangling, and countless moments to learn from students and instructors excited about personal growth and development, human design, and local foods.



This contracted position is a launching point for individuals interested in gaining a broad exposure to education for marginalized farmers, learning about online course administration, and exploring their own professional pathway in facilitation and coaching. Ideal candidates are passionate about self development, curious to learn, and happy when pitching in on tasks large and small to help make our online course run smoothly.

This position will support the back-end administration and virtual facilitation of Mezclada's first online course, which will be offered three times between the fall of 2022 and fall 2023.

Marketing:

• Supporting our pre-launch marketing strategy (This could involve developing the materials, promoting on social, securing speaking engagements through workshops/webinars/podcast interviews, etc.)

IT Support & Communications:

 Communications with farmers/potential applicants with questions (primarily email), answering questions related to how to access the user interface via Teachable, troubleshooting with technology access, notifying applicants of admissions decision

Administration & Course Preparation:

- Coordinating with guest coaches on availability, course contributions, payment, and invoicing
- Uploading course content from Google documents into branded InDesign documents and on Teachable learning platform
- Supporting the review and scoring of applications

Requirements:

- Bilingual in both Spanish & English (this will allow us to keep you on for our Spanish-language courses)
- Availability for all course dates (Nov. 1st, 8th, 15th, 29th, Dec. 6th & 13th) from 6:00-7:30 p.m. CST
- Advanced knowledge of Zoom (Confidence in ability to create breakout rooms,

screen sharing, pinning participants, etc.)

Working knowledge of Teachable or willingness to learn the platform as we go

Working hours:

- Fully remote, 5-10 hours a week

- · Outside of class, hours are flexible

Compensation:
